



Freedom, Movement, Paradox and Energy are the words that best describe Antoinette Rozan and her work.

Antoinette Rozan is a self-taught multi-disciplinary artist whose work spans 2D and 3D mediums, capturing the power and energy of life. With over 20 years of artistic exploration, Rozan's vibrant sculptures and soulful paintings embody joy, movement, and universal symbols of Love, Peace, and Life.

Her work has been showcased internationally, including in prestigious museums, public spaces, and galleries such as the Hong Kong Museum of Medicine and Sciences and Cité Radieuse du Corbusier. Through her art, she aims to remind us of our limitless potential and the transformative power of self-love and freedom.


LOVERDOSE FLAGS

LOVERDOSE is a movement in response to the prevailing gloom, a remedy to unearth the powerful feeling of being alive. These big XXL hearts (1m X 1m) are meant to be a genuine call to nurture the values of brotherhood, love and respect.

LOVERDOSE was born out of a deep need to recreate links between us all, to accept others and cherish diversity. With vibrant colors and energetic brush strokes, these flags are a rallying sign to a common cause: putting our heart back at the center of our lives. This balance is embodied by the characters depicted: welcoming, full of joy, shamelessly expressive, and yet small and humble.














INK MEDITATIONS


Antoinette Rozan's creative gesture, preceded by meditation, is a lively, spontaneous impulse that makes ink come to life on paper, in black and white, or in an explosion of color.

The movements of the brush carry a powerful message: remember to love yourself, for you can radiate freedom, confidence, plenitude, and inspire others on this quest towards themselves. Each of these ink paintings is linked to the Yi Jing - The Book of Change -, one of the founding texts of Chinese civilization. Infused with a contemporary sensibility, Antoinette explores the delicate balance between spontaneity and control, reflecting the fluidity of destiny, nature and human condition.









IMPETUS FOR LIFE

The Elan de Vie series (Impetus for Life) is an expression of the energy we are. It is a representation of the energy we give off, of the dazzling, powerful, self-evident life that is woven into each of us. Everything in our bodies is in motion as long as we are alive.

These sculptures are the expression of the body coming to life in a single line, of life as a subtle balance that we must find in each of us. Copper, an energy-conducting metal, was the perfect answer to symbolize this idea that everything in our bodies is in motion if we except to let it flow.









FREE



This sculpture's welcoming posture invites us to open up to ourselves while respecting others and their particularities. It can be installed in a wide variety of ways, thanks to its astonishing balance. It is the opposite of a 'static' sculpture, more than a statue, it is in movement. FREE in bronze, displayed on its own, embodies the freedom to be oneself. When exhibited in a group, installed side by side, it brings the possibility of being different, of being someone else. All these sculptures come from the same mould. Like our DNA, they are identical. And yet, through their poses, attitudes and colors, they become unique. FREE is a subtle expression of the illusion of difference. It's a call for greater respect.







JUST MOVE

Ranging from 1m high to 2m, the bronze sculptures of the series JUST MOVE create an hypnotic dance to invite us to contemplation, thus meditation, while conveying an urge for movement. This joyful choreography symbolizes the peace, and yet freedom of living beings.


This freedom is even incorporated in the very design as the sculptures can be either aerial or grounded, in one way or upside down. The technical prowess necessary to produce large, balanced and delicate bronze figures is meant to emulate our sense of possibilities.


